



JINGART: Participating Galleries Announced For June 2023

After a two-year hiatus, the 2023 edition of JINGART scheduled from June 1st to 4th will returned to the Beijing Exhibition Center. This year's JINGART has attracted over 50 exhibitors from 11 cities to gather in the capital, jointly creating a professional, international, and localized art fair, bringing a spectacular art feast together.

JINGART will return with leading international galleries with a contemporary and forward-looking perspective, expanding the dimensions of traditional art and developing a localized international art market. Among them were DAVID ZWIRNER、LISSON GALLERY、SHANGHART GALLERY、GALLERIA CONTINUA、TANG CONTEMPORARY ART. At the same time, galleries are focusing on nurturing emerging artists which will bring a new generation of creativity to the contemporary art market in China, such as CAELIS GALERIA, INNER FLOW GALLERY, CLICK TEN ART SPACE, and WESHINE ART SPACE.

In recognition of the JINGART's commitment to examining the latest developments in Chinese contemporary art with an international perspective, this year JINGART has attracted numerous overseas exhibitors with strong reputations such as CARL KOSTYÁL from London, WHITESTONE GALLERY from Japan, LIN & LIN GALLERY, BLUERIDER ART and LITERATI ARTSPACE from Hong Kong, Macau & Taiwan. At the same time, JINGART has also gained widespread support from local galleries with more than half of the participating galleries from Beijing, including N3 CONTEMPORARY ART, HDM GALLERY, LINE GALLERY, TRIUMPH GALLERY, MKBS ART CENTER. Additionally, the participation of galleries from East, South, and Southwest China further expands the artistic landscape of JINGART, such as MADEIN GALLERY, KENNA XU, K GALLERY, D SPACE.

JINGART will also present the highest quality artworks across all media, including painting, sculpture, collection-grade furniture, photography and digital works, contemporary ink painting, and trending art to art Jewellery. Leading galleries such as BARRY FRIEDMAN LTD., NEW YORK from Manhattan, GAO'S GALLERY from AVIGNON, France, and FROGMAN ART from Beijing will present artists ranging from early 20th-century Modern pioneers to cutting-edge contemporary practitioners. GALLERY ALL and COBRA GALLERY, focus on contemporary art and modern design furniture, and they will bring artist works that combine aesthetic heritage and international expression. HORS CHAMPS ART SPACE from Wuhan will bring a series of cutting-edge experimental image works. DAQIAN GALLERY and TAIHE ART, which are committed to showcasing contemporary ink language, as well as MEGA COLLECTION that focuses on trendy art, and LITERATI ARTSPACE which specializes in contemporary art jewelry, will also present a series of refreshing artistic works.

With a focus on the local and a global perspective, JINGART provides possibilities for various artistic and cultural collisions. Constructing a contemporary Chinese art context in the competitive and dialogical international art market. With the efforts of previous editions,



JINGART has won support and praise from the government, partners, and art institutions, and also gained recognition and trust from exhibitors both domestically and abroad. 2023 JINGART will collaborate with more than 20 art institutions, including Gallery Weekend Beijing, UCCA Center For Contemporary Art, X Museum, Beijing Times Art Museum, Inside-Out Art Museum, M Woods Museum, Today Art Museum, Song Art Museum, Beijing Minsheng Art Museum, Red Brick Art Museum, Taikang Space, and Light Society, expanding the visual art scope of the fair and providing a space for exchange in diverse cultural development.
